# Our Brotherhood



**F**OR some time there had been an earnest desire on the part of quite a few of the active workers connected with the German United Evangelical Church to form an organization for men of eighteen years of age and over. After certain preliminary work, mainly in interviewing the members of the church in regard to joining this proposed organization, it was decided to hold the first meeting on Wednesday, October 28, 1925, at which the Rev. William Batz, Pastor of the Church, explained the purpose for which this proposed Brotherhood was being organized. Although there were only a few present, sixteen in number, all were enthusiastic and loud in their praise of such an organization. Since that time The Brotherhood has grown until they now have a membership of over fifty-five.

At the beginning of the current year the first election of The Brotherhood was held, and the following officers were elected to serve for a period of one year: Mr. Adam Trautner, President; Mr. Herbert M. Wille, Vice-President; Mr. John Crawford, Recording Secretary; Mr. Charles James, Corresponding Secretary; Mr. Howard Zimmerman, Treasurer and Mr. William Koehler, Financial Secretary.

The Meetings of the Brotherhood are held in the Hall, East Avenue and Dillon Street on the second and fourth Wednesday in each month, the first meeting being devoted entirely to a Social evening, and the second meeting being devoted to business; after which a light luncheon is served.

Although The Brotherhood is still in its infancy they are contemplating some important events in the near future, and they cordially invite all men of the German United Evangelical Church, and those living within its vicinity, to become members of this organization and share in the future growth of this association of men.
