

The semi-annual Congregational meeting of the United Evangelical Church was called to order on Sunday January 26, 1986 at 11:50 A.M., President Mr. George Tuerk presiding.

The secretary read the minutes from the previous Congregational meeting. They were approved as read.

Reports from Church Organizations were approved as reported.

Final Sour Beef and Oyster Supper profits were: \$9600.00.

Mini-Bus Fund is over \$3000.00. The Church School has donated \$500.00 to the Fund.

Liberty Federal is still paying 11.7% on our certificate of deposit through August 1986. Mrs. Levy informs us that all requirements have been met for Federal Insurance coverage. She expects Liberty Federal to have coverage by the end of January.

Harbor Federal Savings account will be discussed at the next Council meeting. We may use part of the money for another certificate of deposit and leave the balance in the account for emergency funds.

Despite Benevolence being increased by \$3000.00 and large expenditures for repairs and replacements through the Church and Parsonage, we are still carrying a good final balance. Over-all we are in better financial condition than in recent years.

A new refrigerator has been purchased for the Parsonage. The old one would have cost \$150.00 to repair, and since it was so old, it was thought best to replace it.

Motion made by Mr. Rowell and seconded by Mr. Carrigan to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 12:15 P.M.
