The regular monthly meeting of the Church Council of United Evangelical Church was held on Tuesday, March 4, 1986 at 8:00 P.M. President, Mr. George Tuerk presided.

All Council members were in attendance except Mr. Charles Carrigan, Mrs. Gertrude Everett and Mrs. Delores Canoles.

Pastor Fair opened the meeting with a prayer.

The secretary's minutes and the financial report were read and approved.

#### Property Committee

Church School will be inspected on Saturday March 8 at 11:00 A.M. by members of the council. Calvin Gundlach will check on availability of people from the City government to look over the Church School Building and give us suggestions for its use.

Ladies Aide would like to hire a carpenter to build a closet for storage of a bingo machine. Council requested information on the dimensions before making a decision.

Hours for Jim Slechta were discussed. Time was left at 40 hours.

Motion was made by Mrs. Fader and seconded by Mr. Voelker to raise salary for Jim Jenkins to \$25.00 per month with an extra \$25.00 for duties performed during the Lenton season.

Liberty Savings still not covered by Federal Insurance. Expecting coverage by the end of March. Delay has been caused by the number of applications being processed by the government.

Booklet on charges for Church use has been revised. References to Church members charges have been deleted. References to Pastor have been deleted and replaced by the phrase "donations to the Church". Motion was made by Mr. Voelker and seconded by Mr. Carrigan to accept new booklet, motion approved by the Council.

Continued discussion concerning the Pastor accepting Honararia will be taken up when the new budget proposals are discussed next year.

Motion was made by Mr. Parker, seconded by Mr. Voelker and approved by the Council to withdraw \$25,000 from Harbor Federal and place it in a one year certificate of deposit in a Federally insured account with the best yield available.

Mr. Gundlach reported that most checks have been made up and there is still a balance of over \$400.00 in the checking account. We may not need to withdraw from savings to cover expenses this month.

Consistorial Banquet was a success. There was a profit of over \$300.00 and a very good turnout of helpers.

Sour Beef Supper will be held on April 9. Helpers are again needed.
