#### Finance Committee

Liberty Savings and Loan: The 91 day CD has matured and \$547.00 interest was received. Also, a total of \$3,000.00 was removed from the account. This money will be deposited in a CD at Harbor Federal.

#### Mini Bus

Memo regarding the Mini-Bus has been sent out. So far, only 2 people have said they will use the bus.

Purposes of the bus were discussed. Some clarification of the uses is needed. The Council felt the main purpose of the bus was to bring the young and the elderly to Church. Some other Church Groups felt the bus would be used for trips during the week as well as on Sundays. A letter will be mailed with the Christmas Greeting asking if bus service is needed. Service will begin December 21.

## Property Committee

Mr. James Schlecta has been added to the payroll instead of having his contract renewed for cleaning services. This will cost approximately \$900.00 more this year. The job description for this position needs to be brought up-to-date.

The parts are in for Father Leary to fix the clock.

The Senior Citizens Supply Cubbard has disappeared. Many items which were stored have been lost. Items were valued at about \$100.00. A list of items will be made up and signed by Mrs. Jefferson. A motion was made by Mr. Charles Carrigan and seconded by Ms. Susan Rowell for the Church to pay the Senior Citizens Group for the lost items. Motion approved by Council.
