All members were in attendance except for Gertrude Everett, Charles Carrigan, George Carrigan, and Florence Gundlach. Pastor Fair opened the meeting with a prayer.

The minutes and financial reports were approved as read and corrected.

Property Committee

Mr. Tallegsen has fixed the tub and ceilings in the parsonage. Mr. Bauersfeld will meet with the bell man to find out what we can do to fix the bells.

The roof has been patched up, but it needs some other work done. The broken window in the kitchen will be fixed this week.

This was tabled until the next meeting.

Calender

The Boy Scouts want to use the hall on May 18. They did not give
us enough information to approve the event. The senior citizens were
already using the building from 10-3 that day.

The Aerobics class was discussed. It was decided that the
program will be turned down for now, and the proposition will be
reviewed in the fall. We will also need information on the class
size, insurance, and our compensation for the program.

Old Business

contract for a total cost of \$1190. A motion was made by Mr.
