

September 1, 1987

The regular monthly meeting of the United Evangelical Church was held on Tuesday, September 1, 1987, President, Mr. William Voelker, presiding. All were present except for Mr. Charles Carrigan, Mr. George Carrigan, and Mr. Jim Tallagsen.

The minutes and financial reports were approved as read. Pastor Fair made the suggestion that we inform the congregation of the fact that we are not taking in the money we need to operate in the black. Mr. Voelker suggested when we pay out money for the bus and the air conditioner it should be recorded in the same account as the receipts are.

This money will be needed before October 1.

A motion to hold back the benevolence until later in the year was made by Mr. Paul Bauersfeld and seconded by Mrs. Sharon Daniloski. The motion passed unanimously.

PROPERTY

The roof has now been taken care of.

ALTER

The candleabra will cost \$60 a piece, for a total of \$120. The chains will not cost that much.

FELLOWSHIP

The annual Sour Beef and Oyster Supper was brought up by Mrs. Fader. She reported that oysters were too expensive to serve this year. She suggested that we eliminate the oysters to reduce the cost of the supper.

A motion was made to have a Sour Beef Supper only--with the price being \$7.00 a ticket--by Susan Rowell, seconded by Mr. Lou Parker. This would be a temporary change until the oysters are healthy again. An announcement would be made to the congregation. The motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

Air Conditioners--It will cost \$560 to put timers on the air conditioners so they can be set to come on on Sunday mornings. It will also cost \$100 to rebrick the chimney. We will pay 1/3 down, 1/3 on delivery, and 1/3 on completion of installation. Each payment will be \$4610.

A motion was made by Mrs. Grace Fader and seconded by Paul Bauersfeld to purchase the air conditioners from Chesapeake Environmental Engineering for the agreed upon terms. The motion was unanimously approved.

The stain glass windows will be inspected to see if they need work.
