Council Meeting Minutes  
of meeting held on June 6, 2000

**Those present:** Cal Gundlach, Clarence Rowell, Stan Huber (absent), Ric Nyborg, John Williams (absent), Baptist Hoffman (absent), Harvey Jacob, George Nassner, Cass Young, Olga deBloom (absent), John Price, Darlene Waters, and Pastor Baker

- Meeting was opened with prayer at 7:30 pm.
- The personnel committee membership was being corrected with Bill Single replacing Darlene Waters to avoid a conflict of interest.
- Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted with minor corrections.

**Financial Report**

- Cal Gundlach reviewed the financial situation, we are still about \$25K behind the budget. Harvey said this report did not include the interest from the \$100K CD. The parsonage expenses were reviewed. The parsonage expenses have caused much of the deficit but the improvements are nearly complete.

  - 1) The NA group at Resurrection Methodist is looking for meeting place for their meetings.

**Committee Reports**

- **Property:**
  - 1) John Price reported on the status of the parsonage: He wants to know if we are considering it a rental issue. A motion was made to wait on the decision until after making the choice for new pastor. We may consider using JHU Bay View as a

source for rental in the future.

- 2) We are still trying to determine how to refinish the front doors of the church; we are putting a notice in the church bulletin for volunteer labor.
- 3) We have begun to rent our hall out to three (3) recovery groups for weekly meetings at \$80 per month each. George Nassner recommended the executive committee accept John Price's submission of changes to the by laws to have the meetings approved for insurance purposes.

Three (3) potential new members are sick but will be contacted in the future.

- 1) We reviewed the spaghetti dinner and realized a \$500 profit. We will explore a date in September for the next one.
- 2) We are looking at ways to attract younger adults. Pastor baker said these people want to see how their joining will make a difference and want church programs that have beginnings and endings.
