

**United Evangelical Church
Council Meeting Minutes
Of Meeting Held June 12, 2001**

Committee Reports:

Financial Report: Harvey stated that while all bills are paid the amount of money in the savings account is much lower than it was three or four years ago. He also reported that a lot of money has been spent recently on postage expenses.

Correspondence: UEUCC donated \$ 1,000 to UCC in year 2000. The amount to be donated in 2001 has not yet been decided.

Property Reports: Internet Provider (Star Power) costs \$ 300 a year. John raised the question of whether the church should keep it or not. John will look into Juno, another provider. John spent half of a day fixing the stained glass window inside church. George went to CHICA meeting for Sprint Contract with UEUCC – zoning should be approved in September and the contract should be in place by year end.
