All were in attendance except for Mr. Jim Tallagsen, Mrs. Gloria Rolphing, Mr. Paul Bauersfeld, Mr. George Carrigan, Mr. Charles Carrigan, and Pastor Stephen FAir.

The minutes and financial reports were approved as read.

The financial report stated that there were many extra expenses for the Month of March. Repairs and expenses included; the organ, bus, paint for the ceiling. The boiler sprung a leak, the freezer needs to be replaced, and the Sunday School door was damaged.

The council approved giving Mr. Calvin Gundlach \$2,000 to operated the mini-bus through the summer months.

The women's Guild will buy the new freezer. It will cost \$539.95 from the G&E company.

The Sunday School door was repaired.

Mr. Jacobs donated his time to repair the organ.

The air conditioners have not been finished yet, and we are having problems getting in touch with the man.

Two weeks ago their was a fire in the parsonage. It was discovered that their was a fire violation in the parsonage boiler room. It was taken care of.

Alter

The new acolytes robes will cost approximately \$300. Since the church is low on funds at the moment it was discussed that perhaps the Youth Group or the Ladies Aid could pay for the robes.

Mrs. Fader stated again that she will need more help this year for the Sour Beef and Oyster Supper if it is to be held.

Music

The choir show will feature the Sweet Adelines. Ticket sales are not going well. The choir is advertising for this show.

Rob will be allowed to use the mimeograph machine to run off the booklet for the show.

Mini Bus

Repairs have been made. We will put a lock on the gas tank.

Bull Roast

We have deposited over \$1900 in the account.

Anniversary Sunday

Signed contract for music and hall. We have gotten the Captain's Quarters for the church service-they are a quartet.

New Business

Telephones-we are still investigating whether or not we should buy our phones. Sharon will investigate our situation.
