

November 27, 1988

The semi annual congregational meeting of the United Evangelical Church was held on Sunday, Nov. 27, 1988 immediately following the 10:30 church service, president, Mrs. Grace Fader presiding. There were 51 people in attendance. The minutes were approved as read.

Budget

The proposed 1989 budget was presented to the congregation by financial secretary Calvin Gundlach. The only question was from Mr. Parker concerning the elimination of the church's contribution to the Chesapeake Center--this was discontinued because the council has seen no progress. We may reevaluate this at a later date if we see some progress. A motion was made by Clarence Rowell and seconded by Margeret Shore to accept the budget as proposed. The motion passed unanimously.

Mini Bus

The bus is not self supporting. We have has a lot of vandalism, as well as insurance problems. About 10-15 people ride the bus each Sunday (both services combined) Mr. Walsh suggested that we use cabs to transport the people. Mr. Voelker said we would probably have to give the bus away, as we probable could not sell it. The income from the bus is about \$20.00 a month.

Mr. Jacobs asked about storing the bus off street. We would still have the same vandalism problems. Mr. Bauersfeld stated it takes about \$4000 a year to run the bus. Norman Parker said he could possible arrange for long-range storage of the bus. Mr. Walsh said we should give the council the authority to get rid of the bus.

Mr. Voelker made a motion for the church to dispose of the bus and for alternatives to be discussed. Motion passed unanimously. The use of the bus will stop when the insurance runs out (this Sunday). Mrs. Rowell suggest that we have a list of people in the church office that are willing to drive on Sunday's.

Other Business

The church school donated \$500 to the boiler fund.

Mr. Jacobs moved to thank Mrs. Fader for all of her hard work as president.

Motion to adjourn was made by Ed Myers and seconded by Clarence Rowell. The meeting adjourned at 1:15.
