

March 13, 1989

The regular monthly meeting of the Church Council of the United Evangelical United Church of Christ was held on Tuesday, March 13, 1989 at 7:30 pm, president Mr. William Voelker, presiding. All members were in attendance except for Mr. Bauersfeld and Mr. Carrigan.

Before the regular meeting, Mrs. Daniloski came to talk about the bull roast. Dates and locations were discussed. The date that was picked was October 15, 1989 at La Fontaine Blue. A motion to this effect was made, seconded and carried. (Fader/Tallagsen) We will need a \$600 deposit for the hall. This motion also carried. The proposed price for the tickets is \$17. This will be discussed more at a later date.

#### Finance
