

November 6, 1990

The regular monthly meeting of the Church Council of the United Evangelical Church, UCC, was held on Tuesday, Nov. 6, 1990 at 7:30 pm, president, Mr. Clarence Rowell, presiding. All members were present except for Mrs. Gundlach, Mr. Tallagsen, and Mr. Carrigan. The minutes and financial reports were approved as presented.

The church is still \$12,000 in the hole even after the supper, but we should be able to catch up with the holiday's approaching.

Our insurance agent then explained the new policy to us. The insurance will cover all three buildings in a blanket policy. It will also cover full theft, full glass damage, loss of offering, water backup, personal property of the clergy, and personal property of others. There will be a \$250 deductible per incident. There will be \$1,000,000 general liability. Anyone who does not have 100/300/50 car insurance coverage will not be covered by the church policy.

Correspondence

1. A letter from Sharon Daniloski-she asked that she be removed from the auditing committee, and does not want to be on any other committees. It is believed that this is a result of the council's decision to not allow alcohol at events held in the church. We need to evaluate this as a church policy. All parties involved need to participate in this decision. Mr. Rowell believes this should be a congregational decision, not a council one.

2. Art Jones presented his report on the Sour Beef Supper. He is to be commended on the job he did. A copy of the report is attached. Pastor Armstrong suggested that we form a fund raising committee.

3. The Central Atlantic Conference wants to know what we are giving to the OCAWM, and to the other missions.

4. The poinsettias are now \$10.50 a piece for a four bloom plant. We will put the price of the poinsettia in the bulletin.
