

November 25, 1990

The semi-annual congregational meeting of the United Evangelical Church was held on Sunday, November 25, 1990. There were 69 people in attendance.

#### Budget

The 1991 budget reflects a 25% increase, mainly due to the pastor's salary/benefits. Mr. Rowell stated that he hoped the membership would help the church meet this goal.

Salary/Fringe Benefits-The workman's compensation is new. Mr. Cook asked about having employees contribute to their health insurance. If we have them contribute, we would have to raise their salary to compensate.

Maintainence-Mr. Single asked why the cleaning expense isn't higher. Mr. Tallagsen said that we rely on volunteers to help with the cleaning.

A motion was made by Frank Kleiner/seconded by Lynn Sanders to accept the budget as proposed. Motion passed unanimously.
