



Founded by German immigrants, United Evangelical has been ministering in the Canton community since 1873. Oktoberfest is a way for us to honor our German heritage and celebrate with our friends and neighbors. This past year we celebrated our 140th anniversary with a year-long project called "140 good deeds in celebration of 140 years." Over the year we organized and took part in many community projects including:



- coordinating food/supply drives for the Canton Food Bank, the Franciscan Center, and Earl's Place
- cooking and serving meals at the Franciscan Center, Paul's Place, and Earl's Place
- hosting a Red Cross Blood Drive at the church
- crafting and caroling with the residents of Future Care

- participating in the Souper Bowl of Caring to benefit the House of Ruth

SUNDAY SCHOOL

We are blessed to have dedicated volunteers working with the children in our Sunday Church School (9 am). We use a, high quality, vibrant, contemporary curriculum. We have two classes: Nursery/Kindergarten (toddlers to 6) and Multi-Age (7-12). We welcome all children who are looking for a stimulating opportunity to learn about the Bible and God's Word.

ADULT BIBLE STUDY

We offer adult bible study on Wednesdays 10 am and Sundays at 9:15 am (ages 13 and up).

YOUTH GROUP

United's Youth are a focused group of teens who grow their faith by helping others. Each summer they embark on a mission service trip. Previous trips took us to Deer Lodge Tennessee to assist impoverished people of the Smoky Mountains and to Hiram, Ohio to work with Autistic adults. As part of their mission work throughout the year, our youth volunteer with local community based services such as Earls Place, Canton Food Bank, Maryland Food Bank, Homeless Person's Memorial, Church World Service, and the Souper Bowl of Caring. All young people 13-17 years old are welcome to join!
