

ORAL EXAM QUESTIONS - CONFIRMATION CLASS OF 1980

NOTE: Our basic purpose in this examination is to discover and experience a new level of growth or maturity achieved by members of this Confirmation Class. Maturity of faith cannot be measured merely by remembering facts. We use these questions as a starting point for our discussion about that growth which has happened and which needs to continue to happen for these young people. When Council members, parents/guardians, and Confirmands enter into creative dialogue, then additional new growth or maturity can happen together for both teenagers and adults.

9. What are some differences between the Gospels and the Epistles? Are there any similarities?
10. How would you prove that one of the Gospels and the Acts of the Apostles were written by the same person?
11. What impresses you most about the life of Jesus?
12. What impresses you most about the teachings of Jesus?
13. Who was the first Christian missionary? How do you know?
14. How was the Nicene Creed formed? How is it similar to and different from the Apostles' Creed?
15. What do you know about Augustine of Hippo? Boniface? Francis of Assisi? The Crusades? John Wyclif?
16. Who were: Martin Luther, Philip Melanchthon, Ulrich Zwingli, John Calvin, the Anabaptists, John Knox, John Wesley? What did they do?
17. What actually happens during the Sacrament of Holy Baptism?
18. What actually happens during the Sacrament of Holy Communion?
19. What do you mean when you use the word "faith"?
20. What are the duties or requirements of all active church members? How would you define an inactive church member?
21. As a new church member, when should you call your pastor?
22. What parts of our worship together are most meaningful for you?
23. What should U.E.U.C.C. be doing that it is not now doing? What should it not be doing that it is doing wrong, from a Christian point of view?
