This letter is to confirm our telephone conversation of Wednesday, September 4, 1985. I look forward to having you speak to the congregation of United Evangelical Church on September 22, 1985 during the 10:30 a.m. Worship Service. Your appearance is in conjunction with the 112th Anniversary of our founding as a Church.

To give you a little background, I have been Pastor of United Evangelical Church for ten months. I have preached being Born Again in that Church for the first time in about ten years. Subsequently, many people in the Church are not Born Again. They would benefit from hearing about salvation from some other than me. I look forward to seeing you again and hearing what I'm sure will be a Spirit-filled message.

We are easy to find. We are located at the corner of East Avenue and Dillon Street in Canton, near highlandtown. From the Beltway, take I695 toward Essex. At the junction of I695 and I95, take I95 South. I95 will fork about three or four miles south of the Beltway. Take the fork to the right marked South Baltimore, Take the O'Donnell Street exit and head west to East Avenue. Turn right (north) on East Avenue for one block to the corner of East Avenue and Dillon Street.

From Broadway (near Johns Hopkins Hospital) head south on Broadway toward Fells Point. Turn left on to Eastern Avenue. Head east on Eastern Avenue, past Patterson Park, to East Avenue. Turn right on East Avenue and head south to the corner of East Avenue and Dillon Street.
