Speak at Morning and

United Evangelical Church, East Avenue and Dillon Street, is commemorating the 65th anniversary of its founding in 1873 with a month of celebrations during October. The first Sunday, October 9, Founders' Day, will be observed by having Dr. Elmer G. Homrighausen, of Princeton Seminary, Princeton, N. J. as preacher in the Youth Service at 10.15 A. M. and in the evening service at 7.45 P.M. He is a nationally renowned speaker, having taught in the International School at Geneva, Switzerland, Butler University, Indianapolis, Indiana and now occupies the Chair of Christian Education at Princeton Seminary. He has written a book that has caused a great stir entitled "Christianity in America" and is contributor to many magazines.

Interesting Subjects

Dr. Homrighausen's subjects will be "The Church of the Living God" in the morning and "A Cloud of Witnesses" in the evening. Special music is to be rendered by the chorus.

On Tuesday night at 8 P. M. Dr. Oscar Blackwelder, of the Church of the Reformation, Washington, D. C., formerly pastor at Christ Lutheran Church of this city, will speak. Rev. J. Harms of the Baltimore Council, and other Baltimore pastors will bring greetings on this "Community Night" service, which will be in charge of the pastor, the Rev. Titus Lehmann.

An interesting, illustrated 65th anniversary booklet, covering the history of the church, has been prepared and will be distributed at the services.
