Dear Youth Group Member and Friends,

I have some good news and bad news to tell you. First the good news; the Youth Group had a successful show Oklahoma! on Friday and Saturday, August 21 and 22. We thank all of those who participated and came to it. We also had a successful bus trip to Busch Gardens and Williamsburg on August 28-30. Everyone seemed to have a wonderful time, regardless of the fact that only 6 Youth members went!

Now the bad news, the Youth Group advisors, officers and executive committee members have been consulted on the fate of the Youth Group. With the lack of general participation and response that we have been getting, we have decided to disband (at least temporarily). There was limited Youth involvement in our show (5 performers, 3 backstage helpers and 1 advisor) for a total of 9 members active; only 2 members went on the trip to Mrs. Millie's country home and only 6 to Busch Gardens. You cannot continue to grow and prosper with limited participation. But it's not only those who are "active" and don't come, it's those who are "inactive" and periodically come, and those eligible in the church Confirmation age and older, who don't join/come at all. We need more people and have tried practically everything we can think of to get church members and their friends interested but to no avail. The 4 adult advisors, 1 youth advisor as well as some of our officers are also very disgusted with the organization and the church situation at present so we think it best to "call it quits" for awhile and possibly give it one last shot at Christmas time or after the first of the year (but we are not promising anything). If you have any comments to this letter, let us know and Lori Hoffman, Kim Smith or myself will get back to you as soon as we can. We will keep in touch, never the less.

Dear Member and Friends,

The Youth Group's annual summer week-end trip will be to Busch Gardens and Williamsburg this year. We will be traveling again by Huber's Bus Service on a coach-type bus with air-conditioning and rest room facilities. The trip is scheduled for August 28-30 (the last week-end) and it will be a nice way to end the summer. The cost of the trip will be \$55.00 for non-Youth members and \$50.00 for Youth Group members and will include the following: transportation, motel, entrance fee into Busch Gardens, tip for bus driver, and prizes for the games played on the trip.

Our tentative schedule is as follows:

- Friday night - We all meet in front of the United Evangelical Church Office (Dillon Street) at 6 p.m. By 6:15 p.m., we should be putting our luggage onto the bus and we will leave promptly at 6:30 p.m. (no exceptions). A snack and sodas will be served on the bus ride down, as well as bus games being played. We will probably make one stop on the way down, to stretch our legs, etc. We should arrive into Williamsburg about 10:30 p.m. that night. We will be staying at the Econo-Travel Lodge #1, 1413 Richmond Road in Williamsburg, Virginia. (The same place that we stayed when we went there, two years ago). This motel has a pool, two double beds (four to a room), color T.V., air conditioning, telephone and pancake and lobster restaurants in it/near by. The pool may stay open until 11 p.m. but I'm not sure!
- Saturday - We shall leave to go to Busch Gardens (the Olde Country) around 10 a.m. from the motel. The bus will pick us up, take us to the parking lot at Busch Gardens, where we shall ride the shuttle bus to the park's entrance. We shall stay at the park to about 10 p.m., but we may have one group leave around 7 p.m. if they want to (but this is not definite). While in Busch Gardens you can ride the Loche Ness Monster, Water Flume, and other rides, see the various variety and magic shows, or visit Italy, France, England and Germany - which are the countries represented there.
- Sunday - The morning is free to you! You can go swimming in the pool, walk to the restored area (about 1/2 mile), catch a bus to the information center or restored area (I believe), or go shopping (about 1/8 mile away). Around 11-12 o'clock, we will get on the bus and go to either

the Williamsburg Pottery Shop or Jamestown. This has not been decided upon as of yet, but in either case, you will have about 3½ hours here. We should arrive home Sunday night around 7 p.m. with us making a brief supper stop.

I hope that everyone will be able to go with us and I know you will have a good time, because we have had them in the past. This trip is on a first come, first served basis, so get your money in before July 5 (a \$25.00 deposit will do). Have any questions? Well, feel free to call me at 276-4563.




On June 17, we will have another Home Youth Group Meeting to finalize our planned retreat for June.
