Congregational Meeting Minutes  
For January 27, 2002

Meeting was called to order – George Nassner (Council President)

Prayer –Deacon Max Hoffmann.

There were 57 members who attended this meeting.

Last meeting minutes were approved.

**Financial Report** – Calvin Gundlach stated he was pleased with the church's improved finances. Early last year, there was a deficit of \$ 27,000 and presently, it is \$ 1,900. Harvey Jacobs indicated the vending machine revenue (which was \$237) was not included in the financial report. Harvey also stated that each member's statement for 2001 donations was not accurate. Each member will receive a new statement within 2 weeks.

A motion was made by Clarence Rowell to pass the 2002 budget. A second motion was made by John Price and all were in favor of it.

An announcement was made that Olga deBloom had resigned from Church Council.

George Nassner expressed concerns with the lack of volunteers for programs and committees within the church and requested for members to be more active.

George also requested that members with any concerns about the church or council please communicate them to council. He emphasized the importance of communication and how we must unite to make improvements.

The Pastoral Search Committee stated they received a call from an interested candidate from outside of Lancaster, PA.

Denise recommended that the church consider George Nassner as a potential candidate for Pastor if George was interested.

A motion was made by Clarence Rowell to adjourn and all favored it.
