Financial Report: Harvey reported that we fell back some in June. We are under \$7889.33 for June, but over \$8,873.98 for the first six months of 2002. We received \$8,000.00 from Traveler's Ins. Co. for the damage done in the Gym area from the reconstruction that is going on in the house next to us. Harvey made an analysis sheet (see attached) for the first six months of the year. The money from Sprint has really helped us.

Everyone was in favor of this motion except two members. Robert would like to make a second shift, for clean-up people to come in and clean up after the sour beef and dumpling dinner.
