## MOTHER'S DAY

Mothers are like fine collectibles - as the years go by they increase in value. *"Despise not thy mother when she is old."* Proverbs 23:22

Mother's are given a special place in the Bible. It was Jesus, himself, who cared for his mother with such compassion that even while he was on the cross and in great pain he entrusted John, the beloved disciple with the care of his beloved mother, Mary.

On the death of her mother in 1907 Anna M. Jarvis proposed that a day be set aside for children to pay tribute to their mothers. At the special memorial service honoring her mother, Anna provided 500 carnations - her mother's favorite flower - as corsages. (The tradition of carnation corsages lives to this day.)

On May 8, 1914, President Woodrow Wilson declared the second Sunday in May "Mother's day," urging an annual *"public expression of our love and reverence for the mothers of our country."*

However, things didn't work out as Miss Jarvis had planned! The day began to become more of a landfall for merchants than what Anna had intended.

And so, Miss Jarvis ended up spending the rest of her life arguing in letters, pamphlets, and editorials that Mother's day had been intended to inspire simple loving gestures *"through some distinct act of kindness, visit, letter, gift or tribute to show remembrance of the mother to whom general affection is due."*

This is the intention of this book of tributes. Money can't buy the heartfelt love and thanks expressed. The mothers listed on these memorial and tribute pages represent the very best of memories and experiences.

Being a mother is one of the highest salaried jobs since the payment is pure love. And love knows no bounds!

To love a child and be a good mother does not mean one has to physically bear a child, for there are many fortunate children who have been loved by relatives, foster parents and adoptive parents. A biblical example is Moses, who was raised by the Pharaoh's daughter.

There is also HOPE MEADOWS \* built on an abandoned Illinois Air Force base. It looks like any neighborhood, but the tormented histories haunting these children as they play, is what brings them to this village of big miracles.

This is where children who have been shuffled between one foster home after another who are deeply troubled - the "unadoptable" - are given the chance to thrive in permanent homes. Here many seniors, in fact a whole community of *good, committed men and women* become the kind of *Moms and Dads* we give thanks for. They work not because they have to. They give of themselves *out of love* to build upon a shared mission: piecing the shattered childhoods back together of these forgotten children.

*Ask any mother why she does what she does and you are likely to receive the same answer. Love is both a mother's work...and a mother's reward.*

A little boy's mother once told him that it is God who makes people *good*. He replied, "Yes, I know it is God, but mothers help a lot."

It is with many thoughts of love and devotion that we salute our mothers who have *helped us a lot* on our way!



## HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!

What does the word "father" bring to mind for you? My computer dictionary defines father as "*priest, minister, vicar, member of the clergy.*" Interestingly *father* is defined supposing a divine aspect while referring to God's caring.

Webster's NewWorld Dictionary defines father this way. "*A man who has created a child; a stepfather or father-in-law; the person regarded as a male parent and protector; God as the first person of the Trinity; any man deserving respect or reverence because of age, position, etc.; to care for as a father does; protect, rear, take the responsibility for.*"

*Protector, being respected and revered, to care for and take responsibility for a child.* That is quite a list of characteristics and expectations!

The reality is, however, that the answer to defining "fatherhood" has many forms usually depending upon the emotional imprint that our own fathers had on our lives.

For some of us, the response will be a warm memory of love, guidance and nurture. It is only too true, however, for many others the answer will have a dreaded burden of cold discipline, or even abuse, and for others there will be no memory because of paternal absenteeism.

There are 959 Bible verses containing the word "father". (I didn't count them - my concordance told me.) Most refer to *God as father* but also *father* as a key figure in *God's care for us*. We live, then, in the double world of what our own fathers really were and the Biblical picture of fathers called foremost to be "righteous" before God.

In the Old Testament, a father is to love and be responsible for his children. He is urged to be consistent in his oversight and discipline as he models "righteous" living for his children. Biblical righteousness, meaning honorable, virtuous, blameless, upright and moral, comes not only from

living an intentional "good" life with a strong human spirit, but even more, righteousness comes from the Holy Spirit as a gift to those who have faith.

Remember those stories of fathers bringing their children to Jesus to be healed? In Mk. 9 a desperate father brings his child afflicted with uncontrollable convulsions to Jesus whereupon the father says, "If you can do anything, have pity on us and help us." "If you can?" retorts Jesus indignantly, "everything is possible for one who has faith."

So preparation for parenthood begins early in one's own life as we begin to follow the examples set before us of what it means to lead a life of *righteousness* and *faith*. This doesn't mean never doubting or leading a life of impossible perfection. It does mean *trusting in God's promise, expecting and accepting* the God of compassion and hope as central in one's life. It also means *accepting* the forgiveness of Christ when our behavior falls short of "righteousness". (Overdone guilt is a killer!) Our high expectations are also rooted in the trust that *no one* is ever beyond the reach of Divine Mercy.

In the New Testament, the outstanding picture of a loving and righteous father in Jesus' own words is the story of the "Prodigal Son". Rembrandt's painting "The Return of the Prodigal" shows in expression beyond words the warmth and joy all over the face of the father as he embraces with huge welcoming hands the son "who was lost and now is found". *This is a powerful definition of fatherhood.* That is what we celebrate on Father's Day - what God has called fathers to be!

Taken from Moslem custom, the cathedrals of Spain call the exit portal from the sanctuary the "door of forgiveness." We go from the altar into the world as forgiven. The fatherhood of God has taught us that. And so we memorialize our fathers in this booklet.


