RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Drinking or possessing intoxicating beverages on athletic fields or parking lots is strictly prohibited.** Any individual or group planning to consume beer and light wine in those few parks where such is permitted will be required to obtain a park permit approving beer and light wine and/or a one-day alcoholic beverage license.
- It is understood that the person in charge and/or the organization will be responsible for actions and safety of the group and will comply with rules as stated.
- NO SWIMMING** is permitted. Mini-bikes are prohibited in park. Motorized vehicles may go into the picnic area for the purpose of loading and unloading, after which time the vehicle must be removed from the picnic area. This is dependent upon access availability.
- Pets must be leashed. Owners are responsible for clean up. Horses are not allowed on park grounds.
- Moonbounces and/or any inflatables are not permitted on County property.
- Horseshoe playing is allowed only in designated areas.
- The playing of softball in designated areas is permitted. Park attendant will assign diamonds and settle any dispute regarding use of the softball fields. His/her decision is final. (No picnic group may use the field for more than one hour if other groups are waiting).
- Charcoal-type fires are permitted in private or park-owned grills. **NO** Turkey Cookers/Fryers. **NO** open fires of any type are permitted without the approval of the Department and the written consent of the Chief of Baltimore County Fire Department. No fires of any type are permitted inside the pavilions except those having permanent fireplaces.
- Pavilion use is governed by reservation. In the event that a pavilion is not used, the park attendant will make the space available to those without reservations.
- Groups or individuals using the park are expected to clean up their debris and restore the area as much as possible to a clean condition.
- The park closing time is sunset (unless otherwise noted on permit).**
- If you find it necessary to cancel your permit, please contact us as soon as possible so that someone else may be able to utilize the date you requested.
- The park attendant is the final authority in any dispute regarding the interpretation of printed park rules and regulations or in any other matter that may arise that is not covered by the park rules and regulations.
- Any violation of the rules and regulations shall result in revocation of the park permit, and the group will be required to vacate the park. The group may also be subject to legal action.
- NO** loud or amplified music permitted without prior approval of the department staff.
