RESPONSIVE READING

Follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.

And the servant of the Lord must not strive;

But be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient:

In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves;

If God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth:

And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. (2 Tim. 2:22-26)

But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them;

And that from a child thou hast known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness;

That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. (2 Tim. 3:14-17)

Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the Scripture is of any private interpretation.
