Dear Friends in Christ Jesus :

" Bear you one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ." This means in other words share of that which God has given you, in order to build His Kingdom. We ask you therefore to get your envelopes on next Sunday, the 15th. of December in the Sunday School Hall of the United Evangelical Church, and use them, by bringing in your gifts every Sunday.

The tentative budget for the year 1941 is as follows: For preaching of Gospel, administration of sacraments, pastoral care \$ 2500.00; For ministry of sacred music, organist and choir director \$ 760.00; For constant care of God's House that it may be warm, clean and useful; (Sexton) \$ 1000.00; For administration of affairs in the church, for bulletins, stationery, printing and postage \$ 500.00 plus Secretarial help of \$ 400.00; For coal, gas, electric, repairs, insurance, telephone, gas and oil \$ 1500.00; For miscellaneous items \$ 300.00 making a total of \$ 7395.00 for Current Expenses of the Church.

For Building Fund to reduce indebtedness of \$ 13000.00 we would like to have \$ 4000.00 to pay off plus \$ 585.00 in interest.

For Penevolences we need at lease \$ 1300.00
