Dear Members and Friends of United Church :

The word which sums up your pastor's Lenten Call to you is "Holy Communion." We have observed that a good number of our members have not communed for some time. Let us make a special effort to attend Holy Communion this year for the sake of your own soul's good.

But the word "Communion" also refers to the fellowship which we need to have in attending church services regularly. In our Friday night services beginning on February 28 at 7:45 P.M. the pastor will deal with the vital subject; "The Seeking Savior". In the Sunday night services the general subject will be; "Abiding Values" which all of us are seeking in this time of upset and turmoil. Do not forget the Youth Worship Services at 10:15 A.M. Bring someone with you to the services!

That word "Communion" has another implication in this connection, it refers to the sharing of responsibility. We all must have a share in the great responsibilities which our "old church" has to carry. Of the 1000 Self-denial envelopes sent out last year only about 350 were returned. Is that fair? Save something in these envelopes every day and bring in at Easter time. This money is to be used for the paying off of our indebtedness. Do your part. Thank you.

The subject of the pastor's report was "Christian Cooperation" and the sharing of the larger work by all. We were thankful for the various services rendered by many people. 95 English and 58 German were conducted. Various other services carried on. The pastor officiated at 114 baptisms, 108 weddings; 104 burials; confirmed 82 children and 22 adults, gave communion to 2436 and made 2210 calls during the year.


