Dear Friends:

The Sunday School, with the cooperation and consent of the Church Council, has agreed to give a free picnic to the members of the Sunday School. However, in order to do this certain measures and steps had to be taken to determine what members of the Sunday School would receive a free ticket.

A committee was formed to study this problem and to draw up rules to govern who was to receive a free ticket.

Below are the rules that were agreed upon at our past Teachers and Officers Meeting which was held on May 10th.

Picnic 1955 - Fiscal Year July 1, 1954 to June 30, 1955

Pertaining to New Scholars:

1. Any scholar enrolling after March 31st, shall pay one half of the regular admission.

2. Scholars enrolling between July 1st of the previous year and March 31st of this year must be present 75% of the time up to June 30th.

Pertaining to Yearly Scholars:

1. A scholar must be present 39 out of the 52 Sundays (3/4 of the year) to be qualified to obtain a free picnic ticket.

2. A scholar absent 14 or more Sundays shall pay one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the total price of regular admission.

The picnic will be held this year at Maryland Beach on Wednesday, July 20th.

Tickets for Scholars and others wishing to attend the Picnic will be available at a later date.

VISITATION

There were a total of 723 homes visited.

There was a total of 132 cards mailed invitations because families were not at home at the time of the call to invite them.

There were approximately 30 homes that were mailed invitations because of the distance involved in trying to visit same.

There were 23 persons who had moved and their address change could not be obtained. It is presumed they are no longer interested in this Church.

There were 22 persons who had moved and their addresses were obtained.

There were 6 reported as now attending other churches.

Approximately 12 to 15 cards had notations of persons ill, whom the Pastor has or will visit.

There were 4 cards marked "no interest."

Several cards were marked indicating persons were very pleased that someone had called to invite them. The overall remark of all persons returning cards was to the effect that in the majority of homes they were received most graciously.

Dear Friends:


