Dear Friends:

" CHALLENGE TO OUR FAITH "

WE have put much effort into the building of the New Church within recent years. Soon it will be paid for, because the members have been generous. NOW we have a CHALLENGE that will ask the BEST of us. We need a challenge to our faith to make the fullest use of our calling CHRIST. We have the equipment; now we must build character and souls. We must confront people with Christ, help our children and young people and through study and worship grow in the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.

" A CHRISTIAN AND HIS FAITH "

is our theme for - RALLY DAY - September 25. The various aspects of our Christian Faith will be illustrated through striking symbols. Our service at 8:00 A.M. stresses this theme. Sunday school will begin at 9:30 A.M. on that day and the children and young people will join us in service at 10:15 A.M. Our Faith must be shared. Children invite children! Youth invite Youth! Adult invite Adults! SPIRITUAL BUILDING begins within as we attend worship service and Sunday school every week. In order that we might reach our goal of - THIRTY FOR SIXTY - we need to increase our attendance by about 185 for each Sunday.

is the title of a series of sermons for the fall Sundays. On October 2 we will observe - WORLD-WIDE COMMUNION SUNDAY with HOLY COMMUNION at 7:45 A.M. and 10:15 A.M. Subject: "Faith in the Christ of the Lord's Supper." Please, return enclosed World-Service envelopes on that day.

begin at 4:30 P.M. on Tuesday, September 27th for the BOYS and on Thursday September 29th for the GIRLS. On Saturday October 1st a class for those under twelve years old coming for two years (Juniors) will begin at 9:00 A.M. Those who cannot arrange to attend the other two classes and wish to be confirmed in 1961 will meet at 10:00 A.M. Children should be at least twelve years old for confirmation.

" P R O B L E M S S O L V E D B Y F A I T H "

God alone can solve our problems such as anxiety, worry, ill-health, troubles, difficulties in families, loneliness, guilt, because of sin, and many others. A "FAITH AND HEALING SERVICE" could be very helpful to us. So the Church Council and the Pastor are arranging for a quiet hour of prayer. Our Church is to be open for prayer and quiet meditation once a week. We will meet on Wednesdays from 7:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. Our first quiet service will be on September 28th. If you have problems write these on a piece of paper and give it to the Pastor, so that he might study some of the situations. Such a "HEALING MISSION" can be of great value as we all pray about it and take an interest in it.

HAVE FAITH -- PRAY -- GIVE ----- WORK FOR CHRIST AND HIS CHURCH.


