

INSTRUCTIONS
for
SCHOLARS OF CONFIRMATION CLASS

I. Purpose of CONFIRMATION:

To help boys and girls twelve to fourteen years of age to learn to know Jesus and that they shall desire to become Christlike in their own every day life. To learn to know the Bible in such a way that can use it in life and to meet life's problems. To prepare the way for an intelligent confession of their faith. To appreciate and join the church as a great force for good in the world. To dedicate themselves to Jesus Christ as their personal Savior.

II. TO THE SCHOLARS:

The Boys meet on Tuesday at 4.30 P.M.

The Girls meet on Thursday at 4.30 P.M.

Be on time as we begin promptly.

Each scholar must bring his catechism, Bible, notebook and pencil.

Each pupil is required to be in Sunday School at 9 A.M. in Youth Worship Service at 10:15 A.M. or the Evening Service at 7:45 P.M. unless sickness prevents.

Each pupil must bring in a written report of the sermon preached on the Sunday previous.

Each scholar must learn his assigned memory work and do the required written work.

Each scholar is asked to read a portion of the Bible every day.

Each scholar is asked to have private prayer and devotion every day.

III. TO THE PARENTS:

We ask the parents to cooperate in the work of instruction by helping children learn their memory work.

Will parents please have "Grace" at the table and also have their family devotions every day, gathering for a reading of a passage of the Bible and for prayer?

Will parents see to it that the children get to Sunday School, Church and to confirmation instructions on time?

The pastor asks the cooperation of all in prayer so that the work of the instruction might be helpful to the confirmants.
