The Spirit of Christians in War-Time

1. Give first concern to prayer that God may lead nations to justice, goodwill and peace.
2. Maintain unbroken universal fellowship with Christians of warring nations.
3. Preach and practice Gospel of forbearance, forgiveness and reconciliation.
4. Enter into fellowship of suffering with millions in hardships and privations.
5. Resist all propaganda of hatred.
6. Disentangle nationalism and Christian religion.
7. Create the will to peace in practical way
8. Stand for settlement of disputes peacefully.
9. Safeguard civil and religious liberties given to all under our constitution.
10. Encourage government in attempt to do the right thing.
11. Set no god above God, the Father of all, who is suffering with men and cooperating with them in their struggle for peace.
12. Uphold Jesus Christ the Prince of Peace and bring Him into hearts and lives.
13. Be repentant in your own heart for the blame of the sin of war.
14. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called the sons of God.
