

ARTICLE V - Administration.
Section I : The Church Council.
Personnel:

(a) The Church Council of this Church shall consist of twelve (12) members, six (6) of whom shall be selected annually, to serve a term of two (2) years. No member can serve more than three (3) consecutive terms.

Eligibility

(b) Only such persons who have attained the age of twenty-four (24) years and who have been members of the congregation for one (1) year or more are eligible for appointment to the Church Council.

Manner of Selection and Appointment.

(c) 1. At the regular September congregational meeting the President of the Church Council shall appoint a committee of five (5) which Committee shall select the new Council members for the ensuing term. This Committee shall be composed of two (2) members of the Church Council and three (3) members of the congregation, at large. They shall interview the candidates, secure their consent to serve and then report their selections to the congregation at its annual meeting in December. The persons so selected by the Committee shall be deemed to be the final choice of the congregation.

(Old Sub-Sections 2 and 3 deleted).

2. Any member of the Church Council shall be eligible for re-appointment after the lapse of one (1) year after his term has expired.

Installation.

(d) The newly selected members of the Church Council shall be installed into office, in accordance with the prevailing custom by the Pastor on the Sunday following the annual congregation meeting.

(e) 1 and 2 - to remain as is -

Section II : The Junior Church Council.

Personnel:

The Junior Church Council of this congregation shall be composed of six (6) members, three (3) of whom shall be selected annually for a term of two (2) years.

ARTICLE IX - Committees.

Add the following new paragraph - 1a

The auditing Committee shall further, have the power and authority to audit the books of any organization connected with this Church provided, said Committee ~~should~~ ^{SHALL} consider such action advisable or necessary.
