CALL TO WORSHIP:

Pastor: And He said unto him;

All: "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind."

Pastor: And a second command like unto it is:

P-: Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts;

MEDITATION-PRAYER-RESPONSE (I Corinthians 13)

P-: "Love is kind and patient, and feels no envy".

All: We think of the patience of Jesus with His disciples, his followers, and all people and with ourselves. We think of His unfailing love.

P-: "Love does not give itself airs, or think too well of itself."

All: We think of Christ's wonderful humility. He who had a right to think much of Himself, thought only of glorifying God! He wanted to draw men to Himself and thus to God.

P: "Love is never offensive, and never puts itself first."

All: We think of Christ's courtesy; His respect for everyone, His self-control and reserve. We think of His unselfishness; His disregard of His own comfort and convenience; His willingness to help others, always forgetting Himself to serve men.

HYMN RESPONSE: "Lord, Teach us the Lesson" - No. 181 - Elm.

"Lord, teach us the lesson of loving, the very first lesson of all, O Thou who dost love little children, How tender and sweet is Thy call! Now help us to hear it and give Thee, The love Thou art asking today--Then help us to love one another, For this we most earnestly pray."

P-: "Love does not yield to provocation, or keep

an account of injuries."

All: We think of Jesus, who never lost his temper. He did not brood over insults. He always remembered and expected the best, and not the worst in people.

P-: "Love takes no pleasure in evil, but rejoices in all honesty and goodness."

All: We think of Jesus who hated sin, but loved the sinner. He knew the joy and beauty of goodness.

P-: "Love is always tolerant, always ready to believe the best, always hopeful, always patient; love never gives up."

All: We think of Jesus and His love and realize that through it we and all men are saved. We pray for that Christ love in our hearts.
