REMARKS by Pastor

RESPONSIVE READING:

PASTOR: Whosoever heareth these sayings of mine and doeth
them, I will liken him unto a wise man which built his

abundantly serve our Lord Jesus Christ and our fellow-
men;

ALL: We break this ground.

PASTOR: That we may with joy learn of his great love and come
to teach others of his saving power;

ALL: We break this ground.

PASTOR: To the glory of God, the love of Jesus Christ, our
Savior and by the Grace of the Spirit;

ALL: We break this ground.

IN UNISON: Bless us this day, O Lord and guide us in the
straight paths, that what we begin here today may be
all to thy honor and glory and to the blessing of our
fellowmen.

Then shall the spade be put into the ground, and the ground be
broken, and we shall know that a good work is well begun.

The pastor, the president of the Church, the chairman of the
Building Committee, the Superintendent of the Sunday school shall
first break ground, and then visiting Pastors.
