In June we had our Fun Night and the proceeds from this affair was given to Eder Seminary as a memorial to our late Pastor, Titus Lehmann D.D. This amounted to over \$300.00.

In the fall we held a seminar or workshop for our teaching staff. The purpose of this workshop was to help them realize the many possibilities, new ways and materials that could help them with their teachings. It was the opinion of all that we have more of these in the future.

We were also able with the Council's permission to have a new modern and stronger amplification system installed in the Auditorium and Church. This included four lavaliers or microphones, along with stands outlets and new wiring. The Church School paid \$2200.00 for this.
