
Dear Sirs:

It is with regret that I must advise you of my intention to terminate my position as Director of Music at United Evangelical Church.

Unfortunately, my full-time job is consuming more and more of my time, and, has become extremely demanding. I hope you will appreciate that although I have tried, it has become increasingly difficult to continue with a schedule which includes obligations seven days out of the week, and often as many as four nights. Being employed as an organist even eliminates the chance of having a day off for a holiday.
