HOW TO ACCESS THE DATABASE

Open your web browser (Internet Explorer, Netscape, AOL, etc.)

In the address line type the following exactly as it appears below.

Press the enter key or click the "Go" button on your browser.

If you have problems with your password being invalid, please note all letters are in uppercase. The number 0 and the letter O look very similar when printed. If you have either of these in your password, and your password does not work, please try the other. Please note your password should be eight characters long. If you cannot get your login and password to work, please contact your conference office for assistance.

Please select Church from the "User Role" drop down menu. Enter your login and password, and click "Login"

You will be taken to a listing of your pastoral staff. If you need to make any changes, please click on the button that says "Click Here to Make Staff Changes." After you click this button it will disappear. (You are only required to click this button once for all changes you make. It is imperative that you click this button if you need to make changes as this will alert our office to the change.) Now you'll need to click on the link that says "No, this information is incorrect." This will take you to a new screen to make any necessary staff changes. After each change is made you'll be taken back to the original staff listing screen. If you need to make additional changes, simply click the "No this information is incorrect" link to return to the edit screen. Once all changes are reflected on the staff listing page, click the link that says "Yes, this information is correct."

After your staff listing is correct, you will be taken to a screen to check your church address information. Make any corrections necessary here as well, and follow the onscreen prompts. (When typing any text on the form, please use capital letters, unless it is your email or web address.)

Please be sure to click on the "Save/Continue" link at the bottom of all data pages to save your data to the database. Clicking this will continue you to the next screen. If you need to go back to a previous screen, do not use the "Back" button on your browser, please click the link at the top of the screen to return to the desired screen.

Please note, in order to enter Christian Education participants you must select "yes" you have a Christian Education program. If you do not select yes, the numbers you enter in your participants section will not save. Also, be sure to complete the Research Questions. When you have finished the Research Questions, please click the button that says "Submit." This will save the information to our database.

The final screen is the confirmation. Please review all data you've entered here. If you need to make any corrections, click on the desired link at the top. When all corrections are made, click on "Confirmation" at the top of the screen to return to the confirmation screen. You may print a copy of this screen, by selecting File - Print. If you'd like to save a copy of this in Microsoft Word, click on the button at the bottom that says "View in Document." You will be prompted to either save or open the file.

If all your data is correct and you will not need to add any additional data, please click on "Submit." Click on the "Log off" link on the top right side of your screen. Then close your internet browser to ensure the connection to our database is severed.

After you click "Submit" you will not be able to alter any data. You'll need to contact your conference for any data modifications. You can still return to the system to view your data.

Simply download a copy of each form and you can complete it on your computer. You will need to have Adobe Acrobat Reader in order to do this. If you do not have this program it can be downloaded for free at <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>. Follow the instructions provided on this website to download and install.

The Local Church Report (Form G) has been printed and your conference has likely mailed this to you along with this letter. Full instructions for completing this form will be available on January 4th at the above listed website.

We are again offering an online system for you to submit this information. Your conference must decide to participate in this system. If they have opted-in you will receive further information from them regarding this.

Please adhere to the deadlines your conference has established and communicated to you. It is important for us to meet our deadlines in order to meet the publication date. Without your help the Yearbook would not be a useful tool. Please be aware that the data you provide may not be included in the 2010 Yearbook if you miss your conference's deadline. We do our best to include all data we receive, but after the deadline there is no guarantee we can include data.

If you should have questions or comments regarding the Yearbook process we ask that you communicate them with your conference or association. They will in turn communicate with us if they need. We'd love to be able to communicate directly with all of you in the churches; however, this is not feasible if we are to complete the Yearbook in a timely manner.

Enclosed is your Local Church Report Form for the 2010 UCC Year Book. As you will note from the letter on the other side, all other forms are available to download from the UCC webpage or I can send you the other forms via email.

Each year the National UCC completes a yearbook. Each year the CAC receives back about 50% of the forms from our churches. We are still working with inaccurate membership numbers for many of our churches. We would like to have as many of these reports returned as possible. Please take the time to complete all forms.
