Miss Le Brun Suggested these organizations make reports to the groups who sponsor them.

Mr. Mueller appointed a Committee headed by Mr. Fred Gross and consisting of Mr. Bark, Mrs. De Vaughn, Mrs. Fader and Mr. Bauersfeld to look into these organizations to see what they need and report to the Church Council their findings.

Rev. Lehmann read his letter to the congregation for 1952.

Mr. Gross suggested we send a letter to Mr. Myers thanking him for the find job he did as Financial Secretary for the last 5 years. This will be taken care of by the secretary.


More social affairs for members of the congregation was suggested by Mr. Fader.
