A Special Meeting of the Church Council was called by its President Fred W. Gross. The following members of the Church Council were present and voting throughout, Fred Gross, George Hoffman, Henry Smit, Frank Hutchinson, George Hammerbacher, Howard Jenkins, Ernest Jones, and William Bark, Jr., and Albert Fader, Sr.


A motion was submitted by Albert Fader, Sr., and Frank Hutchinson seconded said motion, that the Church Council cancel the authority given to George Hoffman to purchase the Hammond Organ for a price of \$3,727.00, such authority having been granted to Mr. Hoffman at the Council Board Meeting of January 5, 1954.

The reason for such cancellation was that Mr. Fred Gross, had obtained information about our present church organ heretofore unknown by the Council Board.

The Council Board voted to rescind the authority of Mr. George Hoffman. The vote was eight to one. Mr. George Hoffman desenting.

A motion was made by Frank Hutchinson and seconded by Albert Fader, Sr. that Mr. Fred Gross be given authority to obtain information regarding the rebuilding of the present church organ. The motion was duly carried by the Church Council.
