Mary stood weeping outside the tomb. ~ John 20:11

Our Living Cross service begins with an ugly looking, empty wire cross. I use its barrenness to explain to the children that Easter morning starts out sad, just like the cross looks sad.

John's Gospel is the only place we hear about the sadness that the disciples were experiencing that morning of the resurrection. While we assume that everyone knows that all the disciples were overwhelmed with grief, John is the only one who names the emotion.

The omission of grief in the other Gospels is so true to our own experience in life. There are so many people around us who we know are carrying a heavy sadness but rarely does anyone acknowledge it. This avoidance of grief can be so isolating to the one who is bearing it. Like Mary, the grieving stand alone outside the tomb weeping.

The wisdom of John's Gospel is telling us that every Easter experience is like the Living Cross, it begins in sadness. Even though we hold the promise of resurrection, we will begin our search for that promise in sadness. Eventually, like Mary, we will see that the resurrection has happened and our mourning will turn to joy.

The wisdom of the Living Cross tells us that this transformation from crushing sadness to joy, from anguish to peace, from barrenness to beauty, doesn't happen immediately. It takes time and intentional attention to the emptiness within us, as well as help from the Christian community that surrounds us.

This Easter, whether you are standing by the tomb weeping, or catching sight of the resurrection, or rejoicing over the fulfillment of God's promises, may the peace of God that surpasses all understanding, guard your hearts and minds in the knowledge that Christ is risen, he is risen indeed.

I hate to admit it, but my appreciation for my mom is greater now than it was when she was living. Mothers do so many things that often go unnoticed. Since her death I have been able to see more and more all the good she brought into my life. Almost daily I am visited by wonderful childhood memories, memories that my mother helped make possible.

The truth is that every love relationship is ambivalent, meaning that we have both positive and negative experiences with the people we love. In her death I have found, that for the ambivalences we experience in our relationships, God offers us a healing grace. If we allow for it, grace will come and cover all the brokenness in our relationships. All the unmet needs, all the broken dreams, all the disappointment of unfulfilled hopes are washed away by God's healing grace, and we are freed to see all the goodness that love made possible.

After my mom's memorial service, a friend of our family said that it was obvious that my mother had been a "force for good" in her life. Because I was six years old when my father was killed in a car accident, I didn't know him very well. The few memories I have are of him doing the things he loved to do. I remember him working in the garden after he would come home from work; he loved to garden and work in the yard. I remember him skinning a deer in the garage; he was an avid hunter. I remember him sitting at the kitchen table enjoying a couple of beers at the end of the day; Stroh's was his favorite. I remember him cleaning clams for our yearly clam bake; my dad loved to entertain.

Even though I didn't know him very well, I've inherited all these loves from my father (except for the hunting, yuk!). And when I find myself enjoying my yard, or enjoying company over for dinner or enjoying a beer at the end of the day, I think of him and say a quiet "thank you" for what he has passed on to me.

Currently I am the same age my dad was when he died. This has caused me to pause at times during this year, especially in those moments when I'm enjoying all those wonderful things in my life that he enjoyed. In those moments I have wondered what his dreams were, what was he planning and hoping for, because I can't imagine this being the end.

No matter how old or young we are when we lose our dad, the end of their presence in our lives is hard. In our pain God's love offers us the hope in knowing that our separation is not a permanent one; that one day we will see each another again. And until that day we are to remember, to hold on to, the promises of God, just as we remember, we hold on to, the memories of our loved ones. This booklet is dedicated to the fathers who have passed on to us a lifetime of memories to hold on to.

Whether we have had our dads in our lives for only a few years or we still have them, we each have inherited from them things which enrich our lives. This Fathers Day take some time to think about the wonderful things in your life that have been passed on to you, and either quietly or aloud, remember to say "thank you."

When my mother died, this verse from 1st Corinthians tumbled around in my heart along side all the wonderful memories of her faith, hope and love. It was a poignant experience of living in the truth of these words; the truth that even though we do not remain, our faith, our hope and our love do.

At her memorial service I shared how I was left with the love of a mother who rocked me to sleep in front of the fire; who always made me feel special on my birthday and who brought an excitement to the family gatherings at the holidays.

I was left with the faith of a mother who would bring me to church with her during the week and let me play in the library while she talked with her spiritual mentor. Who took me with her to the UCC family camp at Pilgrim Hills, and who sponsored me on a Koinonia spiritual renewal weekend.

I was left with the hope of a mother who prayed for me all those years when I was off drinking the stupid juice which teenagers drink that convinces us our parents know nothing. These, and so many others, are the places where her faith, hope and love will remain.

On this Totenfest Sunday we all have wonderful memories of the faith, the hope and the love of those who no longer remain. As these tumble around in our hearts we are filled with a mixture of joy and sorrow. This mixture is the tension of faith which offers us joy in the news we will see one another again, even as we live with the sorrow of our emptiness and loneliness waiting for the fulfillment of that time. We witness this tension at the cross where Jesus promised the thief next to him that he would be with him in paradise. His words offered great hope even as the suffering continued.

As joy and sorrow mix in our hearts, I wonder if my mother ever realized how much of her would remain. Did she know that her hope and faith and love would help to soften the loss I felt? In memory of all those we carry in our hearts may our days be filled with acts of faith, hope and love.
