EASTER

"Suddenly two men in dazzling clothes stood beside them. The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, 'Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen.'" ~ Luke 24:4b-5

At the thought of Easter morning my senses are flooded with joy and beauty. Gone is the heaviness and the darkness of death which Lent takes us through. Here is the wonderful relief which comes when that heaviness is lifted and light floods in, bringing great joy.

Our liturgical journey through this dark valley of death to Easter morning reflects the journey we go through in life when someone we love dies. The women who went to the tomb early on Easter morning deeply loved Jesus. Despite the danger of being known as one of his followers, out of love they would risk their lives to make sure he got a proper burial. It was at his gravesite that the light of these two Divine messengers flooded their darkness, leaving them filled with joyful news ~ "He is risen."

This joyful news tells us that all whom we have lost are living in the perpetual joy and light of Easter morning. The promise of the empty tomb is that even though we might still be walking in the darkness and sadness of the pre-dawn hours, the Divine light will soon flood into our lives replacing our sadness with joy.

I heard this promise spoken in one of my favorite devotionals, *God Calling*. It was there that I read, "We live in eternity now." It was a notion that caught me by surprise to think that the life we are living now is not disconnected from the new life we will have eternally. That death doesn't disconnect us from this realm, rather we simply pass through a door into God's realm where we become one with the God of heaven *and* earth.

The news of Jesus' resurrection, the One of heaven *and* earth, awakens us to the reality that we are one with, not disconnected from, those who live in the perpetual joy and light of Easter. May your Easter morning be filled with the hope and light and joy which this good news brings.
