Mr. William Bark, Chairman of our Pulpit Committee, then went into detail as to the expenses and problems involved in obtaining such a man as well as supporting our present pastor and a full time secretary. After a very thorough discussion of these problems, it was decided that we could support this program and a motion was made by Mr. Albert Witzke, seconded by Mr. Julius Will, that the Church Council be authorized to hire an Associate Pastor. The motion was carried.

There being no further business to come before the Congregation, a motion was made by Mr. George Hammerbacher, and seconded by Mr. Mark Strovel, that the meeting be adjourned.

The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.
