

June 4, 1963

Mr. Park received a phone call from Mr. Goldsmith who is the executor of the late Mr. Dieteman's will. This was discussed by Council and it was suggested that we wait until a caveat of the will is filed before we look into

idea of hiring our own counsel.

Mr. Park has sent letter to Lancaster Seminary for obtaining Mr. Gerber for the Sunday when Pastor Rasche and Dr. Lehmann go to Camp Michaux.

Mr. Park then mentioned a visitation to delinquent members and stated in order to cut down on our expenses, we must contact these members.

He stated we should set up a committee to look into the idea of securing an intern from Lancaster Seminary to make visitations to our youth to bring them back into our church.

A motion was made by Mr. Jones to make an application for an intern from one of our seminaries. This was seconded by Bill Single.

Mr. Single then advised that someone had approached him regarding the previous communion services where the congregation took part in the confession whereas now it is all read by the Pastor. Pastor Rasche stated he is willing to go back to using our previous method.

Property - Messrs. Fader and Hammerbacher talked to a gentleman about cleaning up in the Church. He would need about 2 boys to help him. Pastor Rasche will contact this man re cleaning

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regs for parsonage.

Mr. Fader advised that the janitors 90 day trial period is up and that a \$5.00 week increase is in order if we are going to keep him on as Church Sexton. It was agreed by Council that \$5.00 increase be given.

Mr. Ed. West our Church Sexton will work day shift during July and August.

Mr. Fader received a contract for painting and modifying of the gymnasium Friendship Hall and kitchen.  
Price is \$1470.00 - H. M. Redmar.

A motion was made by Mr. Bill Sark to grant the contract, seconded by Bill Claridge.

Mr. Sauer has purchased reg for quiet room in Church.

Mr. Fritze then brought up the idea of Church purchasing their own runner to be used for weddings. Mr. Fritze is to look into price on this and report back to Council.

Pastor Jaschke advised the walls of the parsonage should be washed every year and paint applied when needed. Mr. Fader will take a look at the walls.

Mr. Sauer will check into having the grass plots in front of garage cemented and some shrubbery placed in front of garage.

A motion was made by Mr. Bill Park to purchase utility cabinet for dictaphone in office at a cost of \$15.00. Seconded by Fred Long.

Mr. Bond stated that we have 220 current up to rooms where air conditioners are to be installed. The only problem is - Is the line strong enough to carry the 220.

Pastor Pasch inquired as to whether air conditioner that Ecker has repaired could be used in Choir Room.

Mr. Bond is to check the status of this air conditioner.
