




ALLELUIA!



"Very early on the first day of the week..." Mark 16:2

Stepping out into the darkness of the early morning on Easter day is the highpoint of the entire year for me. That first moment in the darkness is a touchstone to that first Easter morning. I imagine myself walking with those first women who went to the tomb, and I feel a connection with those saints. I am filled with excitement as I anticipate hearing the news that Jesus has risen from the dead.

While I am filled with great excitement about what awaits me, the reality is that they were filled with a terrible sadness. This contrast of emotions is what the paradox of the cross holds. The vertical arm of the cross reaches toward heaven and down to earth, symbolic of God's connection with us through the cross. The horizontal arm reflects the plane on which we live. When we are far from the center of the cross we can be unaware of what God is doing in our lives, just as those first women were unaware.

In life we travel the horizontal arm of the cross. Sometimes we are closer to the center and are filled with joy and excitement over what God is doing. At other times we are far from the center and we are filled with questioning and doubt over God's presence with us.

On this Easter day, you may be like those women on their way to the tomb, feeling sadness over the death of one you loved greatly. And though it may be awhile before you experience the joy which the empty tomb brings, may you walk away from this day with the Easter promise. The promise that through the cross of Jesus we have been, and forever will be, connected with God; and that we share in this promise with all who have died. May the assurance of this thought carry you to the center of the cross.

The Pharisees and the scribes were grumbling and saying, "This fellow welcomes sinners and eats with them." So Jesus told them this parable: "There was a man who had two sons..." Luke 15

One of the things I love most about the Bible is that it doesn't try to whitewash anything. In its pages we find prostitutes, shysters, corrupt politicians, wayward children ... and the list of unsavory characters goes on and on. By its candor about the human condition, the Bible is holding out hope to everyone in every situation. It tells us that no matter who we are or where we find ourselves in life, we belong in God's holy story.

This was the point that Jesus was trying to get across to the religious people when he told them the parable of the man who had two sons. This parable, often called the Prodigal Son, can also be understood as a parable about a Loving Father. By Jesus' words, we learn that the Father unconditionally loves and welcomes us back home no matter what.

Knowing this unconditional love in our lives as children is critical for good self-esteem, and for the ability to establish healthy relationships. This booklet is dedicated to the men who showed us unconditional love, who showed us that we were still worthy of love even when we made bad decisions and wandered far from home. There has been a love that has followed us throughout our lives and has blessed us in many ways, and for that we are grateful.

The reality of the human condition though, is that no one, not even a father, is capable of the kind of unconditional love which God is capable. This is where the Bible once again broadcasts Good News. The Bible reassures us that we don't need to whitewash anything about our fathers, or about our families, because no matter what, we still have a place in the Father's house. Today as you think about, and talk about life with your father, may you also remember and rejoice in who you are in your Father's eyes.

Totenfest Sunday Memorials
November 26, 2006



Totenfest is a German word that means "Feast of the Dead" or "Festival for the Dead." It was established in 1916 by Prussian emperor Fredrick William III as a day to remember that nation's soldiers who had died in the recently concluded Prussian War. It became an important observance in the Evangelical Church in Prussia (established by the same emperor in 1917) as a day to remember not only the war dead, but also church members who had died in the previous year. It was observed on the last Sunday of the church year, right before Advent began.

Throughout Christian history, the church has and continues to remember and celebrate the lives of faithful people who have died. Totenfest is a distinctive practice that grows out of the Evangelical tradition of the United Church of Christ.

"And the One who was seated on the throne said, 'Behold, I am making all things new.'" ~ Rev. 21:5

Totenfest Sunday marks the end of the Christian year. Next Sunday we will hear the prophets telling us to prepare our hearts to receive the coming Christ. In order to step into a new year with ready hearts, it is essential that we pause and acknowledge the places within our hearts that are not ready; the places of our hearts that are broken and in need of healing and newness.

While the passing into the new Christian year is marked on the calendar with a new season, our passing into wholeness is measured by a new season that doesn't always line up neatly with the calendar on our wall. And while the Church around us will soon be singing of hope and peace and joy, some of us may continue to wait with longing for our hearts to know joy again.

Today, as we revisit the moments of the past year when our hearts were pierced by the death of a loved one, or by the milestones of past losses, may we also hear the promise of the Triumphant Christ who told John in his Revelation that ALL things are being made new. This includes even the emptiness of a broken heart.

Even though we may not yet realize the fulfillment of Christ's promise in our lives, we can celebrate that all who are listed in our booklet live in the reality of John's vision. ALL things for them have been made new and theirs is a joy which is beyond our comprehension.

May the thought of their completeness bring us peace, and may we go into the new year with the assurance of knowing that the One who sits on the throne is faithful and will accomplish all that has been promised.
