

Totenfest Sunday Memorial
November 25, 2007



Those who believe in Me,
even though they die,
will live.

John 11:25

Totenfest is a German word that means "Feast of the Dead" or "Festival for the Dead." It was established in 1916 by Prussian emperor Frederick William III as a day to remember that nation's soldiers who died in the recently concluded Prussian War. It became an important observance in the Evangelical Church in Prussia (established by the same emperor in 1917) as a day to remember not only the war dead, but also church members who had died in the previous year. It was observed on the last Sunday of the Church year, right before Advent began.

Throughout Christian history, the church has and continues to remember and celebrate the lives of faithful people who have died. Totenfest is a distinctive practice that grows out of the Evangelical tradition of the United Church of Christ.

"Behold, the home of God is among mortals..." Rev. 21:3

As I look at this year's list of those who have left our church family for their home in the Father's mansion, I am reminded of Paul's words in his second letter to the Corinthians: "...we have this treasure in jars of clay..." Paul is speaking about the great privilege it is to carry the message of the Gospel within us, to be the vessels which house the splendor of Christ.

He is also reminding us that we are made of clay and will return to clay one day, and that the crowning achievement, the great treasure, of our lives is the glory of God which shines through us. In other words, what we do for God is not for our glory but for God's glory.

Paul's words hold true not only in the lives of the saints on this year's list, but for the many lives remembered in this booklet. There is page after page of people who understood that they were simply jars of clay holding the unsurpassable glory of Christ. Through their humility, God has touched the lives of many within our church and beyond.

As we pause to remember them, may we be encouraged and comforted in knowing that the splendor of Christ which they held in their earthenware vessels now holds them. And as we journey now without them, may we be resolved to let such humility be found within our jars of clay as was in these saints before us; that God may continue to work, touching the lives of many.




