DESIGNATING SEPTEMBER, 1973

AS

"UNITED EVANGELICAL CHURCH MONTH" IN BALTIMORE

WHEREAS, the congregation of the United Evangelical Church is celebrating the 100th Anniversary of the founding of their Church; and

WHEREAS, this Church has faithfully and continuously ministered to the spiritual needs of the people of Southeast Baltimore; and

WHEREAS, it has become an integral part of the community and presently has an active membership of 800 parishioners and a Church School enrollment of 300; and

WHEREAS, special services have been planned to commemorate this important milestone in the history of this Church.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WILLIAM DONALD SCHAEFER, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BALTIMORE, do hereby proclaim the month of September, 1973, as "UNITED EVANGELICAL CHURCH MONTH" IN BALTIMORE, and do urge the people of Baltimore to give full and proper recognition to this important event in the life of the United Evangelical Church.
