A special thanks was given to William Single III for his input in this matter. A motion was made to accept the Financial Report by Cissy Funk and seconded by Alfie Schrodt. All voted in favor.

Presentation of 2011 Church Budget: The proposed 2011 Church Budget was presented by Harvey Jacob. Rev. Cathy presented a Narrative Budget for 2011 prepared by the Stewardship Team consisting of Barbara Matthew, Carolyn Noteware and Rev. Cathy Oatman. A motion to accept the 2011 Church Budget was made by Alfie Schrodt and seconded by Pam Sartori. All voted in favor.

Old Business: None

New Business: Rev. Cathy stated that on January 15, 2011 we will have a "Chili and Beer Cook-Off." The Church Council needed six new members to be voted on. Cissy Funk, Diane Borkman and Cal Gundlach agreed to stay on. Karrie Hogan, Pat Jenkins and Glen Koch agreed to run. A motion was made by Cass Young to accept these six members to the Council which was seconded by Marge Seppett. All voted in favor.
