The auditorium will be used at the Exhibition Room.

with them with regards to having group pictures taken.
Pictures to be taken during our celebration month and displayed.

To begin publicizing our Anniversary

Contact Mr. Fortune "Dialing For Dollars" and arrange to have the Pastor
and General Chairman to appear on the program.
Display cards and etc. to be distributed thru-out neighborhood or community
