MINUTES:

At this point in the meeting Pastor Rasche read the notes that he had taken at the December 6, 1971 meeting.

REPORT OF COMMITTEES:

Anniversary Banquet - The date of September 22, 1973 has been set and the Northpoint Gardens had been contacted. Inasmuch as this date was over a year in advance, they would not give a firm commitment. Mrs.

D. Long was then asked to check into another hall and in the meantime Mr. R. Single was going to contact the person he knew at North-point Gardens to see if he could get us a firm date.

Anniversary Program - Mr. A. Block asked for a clarification of this committee as to exactly what they are suppose to accomplish. After a discussion on the matter it was resolved that this committee should prepare an activity program for the anniversary month. In addition patrons are to be secured to help defray cost.

Speakers - Mr. W. ^{BARK} Block reported that a letter was received from Dr. Moss informing us that ~~He~~ would be unable to attend our celebration due to a previous commitment. The names of Yates and Evans was suggested as possible speakers and maybe some dignitaries from the city or state government.

Decorations - This committee is to work in conjunction with the newly appointed committee to be headed by Mr. F. Long

Activity - The chairman was informed that the Calendar Committee was abolished at the last meeting, therefore our chairman deleted said committee from his list and asked Mr. F. Long to take over the chairmanship of another committee to be known as Activity Committee and work in conjunction with the Decoration Committee.

It was suggested that if a display case or two could be obtained to display items of sentimental value to the congregation and other things of interest.

Publicity - Mr. W. Single reported that he would have posters made and distributed thru-out the neighborhood. Articles to appear in the Guide, and the two local newspapers as well as in community papers.

History Book - Mrs. M. Getz asked that if anybody had any previous anniversary booklets available or knew of anyone that may have same, please contact her so that she might be able to use them for her research material.

Youth - This was a newly appointed committee and our chairman stated that he would like for the youth of our Church to take an active party in the program. One suggestion was made was the possibility of the youth making a place mat to be used on the banquet night. A copy of same was shown to the members present of the one that was prepared by the youth of St. Peters Lutheran Church and was used at their mortgage burning banquet.

Photography - This committee is going to try to obtain pictures that were taken years ago of various activities or persons of the Church and same turned over to the Activity Chairman for display. In addition, pictures to be taken during our anniversary month and assembled in a book for posterity

Anniversary Fund - Mr. E. Myers presented the following suggestions for fund raising:

- 1 - Memory Plate - Picture of the first two Churches and Church School buildings, Parsonage, and the present Church, Church School and Parsonage, along with the six pastors.

- 2 - For the children of the Church School coin folders in denominations of one cent and five cent with slots for holding 100 coins. A prize could be given to the first three children in each category for turning in the highest amount of folders.
- 3 - For the adults a certificate to be presented for amounts contributed to this fund, similar to the one used when the present Church was being built. No amount to be so stated on the form.

There was quite a lengthy discussion on the matter as to how the funds were to be used. It was resolved that any money received by this committee was to be put in the Anniversary Fund and same to be used for something within the Church with the recommendation from the Church Council and final approval from the congregation.

CLOSING

Mr. E. Myers stated that at the next meeting of the anniversary committee the specific duties of each committee will be outlined in detail.

The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 25, 1972 at 8:00 P.M. and the entire committee will be notified by mail.

There being no further business to come before the committee was this time, the meeting was adjourned at 9:30 P.M. and was closed by prayer by Pastor Rasche and all joined in with the Lord's Prayer.
