1. It is understood and agreed that the services, foods, and beverages to be supplied are as described in the "Information Section". It is further understood that upon execution of this agreement by the parties, each party shall be bound by all of the terms of this agreement.
2. The hours, hereinbefore stated, shall be strictly observed unless permission is given by the Management to extend them, in which event, the Management shall make additional charges, for the additional time.
3. The Management will not be responsible for articles or clothing lost, stolen or forgotten during the course of the affair.
4. No outside foods of any kind are permitted to be brought within the premises.
5. The patron agrees that in the event of a breach of any of the terms of the contract on his or her part, including but not limited to a cancellation of the above function, the caterer may, at it's option, be entitled to receive, collect and recover a sum equal to the stipulated deposit as and for the liquidated damages of the Caterer.
- *6. The entire balance due is to be paid on demand on the date of the affair. If not paid in this manner, the entire balance will bear interest at the rate of 1 1/2 % per month from the date of said affair.
7. The Management must be notified of any change in the number of guests at least five (5) days before the affair. This will be in the event that this final notification is for a number of guests greater than the guarantee number stated on page 1, then in that event the final figure shall be considered the minimum guarantee.
8. The Patron will be responsible for any damage to the building and for any items of the caterer's equipment, decorations or fixtures lost or damaged during the affair due to the activities of the guests.
