Dear Mr. Myers:

Our art department has considered your request - 4 buildings and 6 pastors on a 10 inch plate. The art work on a 10 inch plate is contained in a 6 inch round. The edge of the plate has a raised border and cannot be used for a sketch. Recently, we made a plate for a town using 4 public buildings in this small plate in the center of the plate. The buildings had to be reduced to such a small size that all detail had to be omitted. This does not make an effective plate and does not allow us to give you quality art work.

Our art department has several suggestions:

1. Use the present day structure of the church only - getting quality art work on your plate - and put the names and dates of the pastors on the back of the plate.
2. Have two plates made - one with the four buildings and the other with the pastors on it.

If you decide on the present day structure, please send us an additional photo so that we can give you much detail and our best art work. Please read instructions for ordering in our catalogue and use the order blank in the catalogue. We hope we can serve you.

Thank you for your letters of Oct. 9th and Nov. 11th. Our offices are now located in Augusta, Ga. - thus the delay in receiving your letters.

We do have your original drawing in our files. If you order plates using this drawing, this would be a reorder thus it would be cheaper. You will note this on the enclosed price list.

To answer your question - it is possible to put several buildings on one plate. We have recently done a plate of the town of Rockmart, Ga. The center showed a school building and around it were 4 church buildings. This is about the limit to be put into such a small space. On a 10 inch plate - your art work takes up 6 inches in the center. We do have excellent artists who are capable of doing this type work. It seems that 5 items would be the limit on a 10 inch plate. We need clear photos of the people or buildings you want on your art work. When the art work is completed, it is sent back to you for your approval.

Enclosed is our brochure. A beautiful catalogue has just gone to press. We hope to be mailing this to our customers in late January.
