

To Honor United Members

Confirmands of past years will be honored Sunday 10 a.m. at United Evangelical Church which this month is observing the 100th anniversary of its founding.

Early church records are incomplete, but since 1927 a total of 3,265 persons has been admitted to membership through confirmation and adult membership.

This year's class includes more than 30 youth who have been preparing for confirmation for two years.

Speaker at the service will be Dr. Ernst Press, Evansville, Ind., who was an interim pastor at United in 1934.

His sermon will be titled "A Cloud of Witnesses."

Coffee hour will follow the service.

An anniversary display, containing various sorts of memorabilia of the church's history, will also be open to visitors.
